

Gaëlle Dumortier joins the Board of the Autorité de la concurrence

By decree of the President of the French Republic of 4 January 2024, Gaëlle Dumortier, senior judge at the French Administrative Supreme Court (*Conseil d'État*), has been appointed to the Board of the *Autorité de la concurrence*, as one of its appointees drawn from current or former members of the French Administrative Supreme Court (*Conseil d'État*), the French Supreme Court (*Cour de cassation*), the French Court of Auditors (*Cour des comptes*) or other administrative or judicial jurisdictions, to replace Béatrice Bourgeois-Machureau, who resigned on 30 July 2023 to take up her appointment as President of the French Anti-Doping Agency (*Agence française de lutte contre le dopage* – AFLD).
