SERIOUS PRACTICES TO THE DETRIMENT OF CONSUMERS AND THE CARIBBEAN ECONOMY

- Negative impact on consumers living on the islands: captive customers** (no alternative means of transport), **already suffering from lower purchasing power**
- Decline in the economic and tourist appeal** of the territories concerned
