Fuel products in Corsica: the Autorité imposes a total fine of €187,490,000

THE FACTS



TEMF (TotalEnergies), Rubis and EG Retail colluded to reserve for themselves, in their capacity as shareholders, a right of passage within the only two fuel storage depots on the island.




THE FINES


TEMF: €115.8 million
Rubis: €64.6 million
of which Rubis Terminal: €430,000
of which Rubis Énergie: €64.2 million
EG Retail: €7 million


THE INFRINGEMENT

A POTENTIAL FORECLOSURE EFFECT FOR NON-SHAREHOLDER COMPANIES, which are dependent on their competitors for access to fuel products.



MARKET DISCRIMINATION
Non-shareholder companies face less advantageous conditions which could affect the downstream competitiveness of the service stations to which non-shareholder companies supply fuel, versus the service stations owned and supplied by shareholder companies (vertically integrated).





A POTENTIAL INCREASE IN PRICES AT THE PUMP, impacting household budgets in Corsica (where consumers are particularly dependent on their cars for getting about).
