Simon Genevaz appointed Head of the Mergers unit



Simon Genevaz has been appointed Deputy General Rapporteur and Head of the Mergers Unit of the Autorité de la concurrence as of 1 May.

She was Head of the Mergers Unit since the creation of the Autorité de la concurrence in March 2009.

In his several positions at the Autorité de la concurrence, he focused on antitrust issues facing recently liberalized markets (handling several cases in the energy sector) and on mergers in the media, food retail and IT sectors.
