Biography

Eshien Chong has a doctorate in Economics (University of Paris-Sud 11), a DEA (Diploma of Advanced Studies) in Industrial Economics-Econometrics (University of Paris I Panthéon-Sorbonne), and a Master's in Economics (University of Paris Panthéon-Sorbonne). He started his career as a Senior Lecturer in Economics and Quantitative Techniques at the University of Paris-Sud 11 (2007-2012) and at the IAE in Paris (2012-2014).

In 2015, he joined the *Autorité de la concurrence*, where he served for four years as permanent *rapporteur* (case officer) in the Chief Economist's team.

He had been Chief Economist at the Hong Kong Competition Authority since 2019.
