

E-mobility : The Autorité sends questionnaires to main stakeholders in electric vehicle charging infrastructure sector

Background

As part of its inquiry into the electric vehical charging infrastructure sector, the *Autorité de la concurrence* sent out questionnaires to the main stakeholders in the sector in order to gather, by 5 June 2023, their responses on several topics related to EV charging infrastructure.

The *Autorité* started proceedings *ex officio* to analyse the competitive operation of the electric vehicle charging infrastructure sector earlier this year, with a view to issue an opinion. A press release was published on 17 February 2023.

As announced, the *Autorité* sent out questionnaires to the main stakeholders in the sector, including:

- charging operators (public and private charging stations);
- mobility operators;
- interoperability platforms;
- local and regional authorities;

- consumer groups;
- professional groups or organisations;
- motorway concessionary companies;
- motorway subconcessionary companies and concessionnaires of non-concessioned road network;
- representatives of co-owners and co-ownership managers.

The deadline for responding to the questionnaires is 5 June 2023.
