- **Wait if you can** — since iPhone 17 brings upgrades in performance, display, storage, and more, it's likely worth postponing a purchase (unless you need a phone right away).
- **Pre-order early** — pre-orders start September 12. If you want to be among the first to get the new iPhone, mark that date down and be ready.
- **Choose the right model for your needs** — if you prefer a lighter phone, the "Air" model might appeal; if you want maximum performance and features, go for Pro or Pro Max.
- **Plan for possible availability delays** — while global release starts September 19, in some regions stock may sell out quickly or shipping may take a bit longer.
