Official price at launch

When Apple announced the iPhone 17 Pro Max in September 2025, the official base price was declared. According to Apple's Singapore store, the entry price for the iPhone 17 Pro Max starts at **S\$ 1,899**. This reflects the "unlocked" — SIM-free — version.

For the U.S. market, the baseline starting price is **US \$1,199**. That aligns with the information provided by major tech outlets shortly after the launch.

Price by storage configuration

Unlike older models that sometimes started at 128 GB, the iPhone 17 Pro Max now begins with 256 GB as its base storage.

Here is a quick overview of how Apple priced different storage versions of the iPhone 17 Pro Max (U.S. MSRP):

The price you pay for the iPhone 17 Pro Max often depends on where you buy it. Official pricing (like the S\$1,899 in Singapore) reflects local taxes, import duties, and currency differences.

If you buy the U.S. version and import it, remember that you may end up paying more after converters, taxes, and potential warranty limitations. Because of that, local MSRP from Apple in your country (or region) is often the safest benchmark.

Deals, trade-ins and promotional offers

Shortly after the launch, some retailers and carriers began offering discounts or financing deals on the iPhone 17 Pro Max. For example, one U.S.-based mobile carrier offered a limited-time discount that brought the 256 GB model down to about US \$999.

This shows that if you're willing to buy with a contract or accept financing terms, it's possible to pay significantly less than the official MSRP. Still, for most buyers — especially those purchasing the phone outright — the advertised base prices remain the reference point.

What price you should expect (in late 2025)

If you are getting a brand-new iPhone 17 Pro Max soon, here's a realistic expectation depending on where and how you buy:

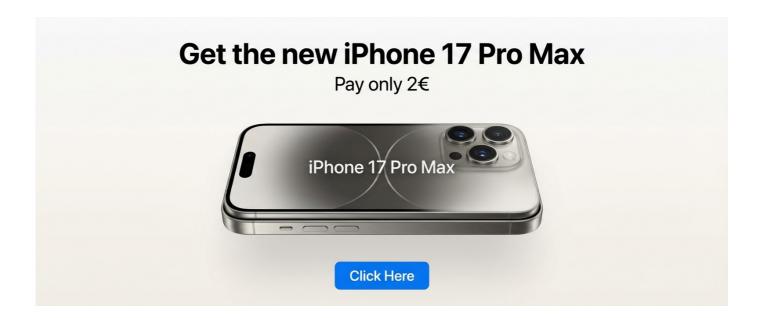
- If you buy directly from an official Apple store (unlocked): expect ~US \$1,199 (256 GB) or ~S\$1,899 in Singapore.
- For higher storage (512 GB 1 TB): expect higher prices, potentially around US \$1,399-\$1,599 or local equivalent.
- If you use carrier deals or trade-in offers: you might pay \$200-\$300 less, depending on discounts or financing plans.
- Imported/unofficial units: final cost may vary significantly due to shipping, tax, and warranty considerations sometimes making overall cost comparable to local official price.

Should you buy it now or wait for deals?

There are pros and cons both ways. Buying directly at MSRP ensures you get a fully supported, warranty-covered device without the complications of contracts or trade-in trade-offs. Also, because storage starts at 256 GB now, you get more value right away compared with earlier base-storage phones. For many users shooting photos, recording video, or gaming, that extra storage can pay off quickly, making the base price more justifiable.
