

AT&T iPhone 17 Pro Max Price in 2025 — What You Should Know

The new is now widely available across the U.S. — and if you're considering getting it through , it's useful to know exactly how pricing works in 2025. In this article, we take a close look at retail price, trade-in discounts, monthly payment plans and what it may cost you out of pocket depending on your circumstance. Everything described here is based on current offers from AT&T and base pricing from the manufacturer.

Retail price of iPhone 17 Pro Max

As of late 2025, the official retail price for iPhone 17 Pro Max starts at **\$1,199.99** in the United States. That's for the base 256 GB model.

Higher storage configurations cost more. For example, 512 GB, 1 TB and even 2 TB models are offered — corresponding to higher MSRP, as is common with Apple's Pro-Max line.

How AT&T pricing and discounts work (2025 offers)

One of the attractive features of buying iPhone 17 Pro Max through AT&T is the trade-in discount plan. If you trade in an eligible phone (from a list including recent iPhone and some Android devices), AT&T offers up to **\$1,100 off** the iPhone 17 Pro Max — applied as monthly bill credits over a 36-month installment agreement.

With that discount, the monthly cost for the phone can drop dramatically. For example, with trade-in and qualifying unlimited plan, the 256 GB model can be as low as **\$2.78/month** instead of ~\$33-34/month.

Without a trade-in, the device is typically paid via a 36-month installment plan. For the base model, that means roughly **\$33.34/month**.

What "up to \$1,100 off" really means

The "up to \$1,100 off" figure refers to the maximum discount AT&T applies — but only when conditions are met: you must trade in an eligible device, activate or maintain a qualifying unlimited plan, and commit to the 36-month installment agreement.

If you don't trade in an eligible device, or if your plan doesn't meet AT&T's requirements, you pay full MSRP — or at least the full installment-plan price. Also, note credits are spread over 36 bills; cancel the plan early or fail to meet terms and you might owe the balance.

Comparing to global/retail pricing (outside AT&T)

For context, pricing of iPhone 17 Pro Max outside of AT&T deals can differ substantially depending on region. For example, in Thailand the official retail price for the 256 GB model is around ฿48,900 (Thai baht), with higher storage

variants going up to roughly \$80,900.

That shows that US retail price plus trade-in incentive from AT&T may still be appealing to many buyers — especially if you're based in or traveling through the US. But for buyers in other regions, local retail pricing and currency conversion can change the value comparison significantly.

Things to check before committing to an AT&T iPhone 17 Pro Max plan

Before you buy, consider these variables carefully:

- **Do you have an eligible device to trade in?** To unlock the full \$1,100 discount you must trade in a qualifying phone (recent iPhone or certain Android models).
- **Are you ready to stay on AT&T for 36 months?** The discount is spread in monthly bill credits over three years, and early termination or plan cancellation can void the benefit.
- **Do you need a high-storage variant?** Costs rise with storage size — for 512 GB, 1 TB or 2 TB models, expect higher MSRP and higher monthly installments before discounts.
- **Understand taxes and extra fees:** AT&T notes that taxes on the full retail price are due at sale even if you opt for installment payments.

Who benefits most from the AT&T offer

The AT&T deal makes the most sense for someone who:

- Already owns a recent iPhone or eligible device that qualifies for trade-in.
- Plans to use the phone with AT&T and stay on an unlimited plan for at least 36 months.
- Wants a flagship iPhone Pro Max but aims to minimize upfront or monthly cost.
- Is fine with installment payments and understands potential long-term commitments.

For such users, the effective monthly cost — after credits — may come very close to the cost of a mid-range phone, while giving them the latest top-tier hardware.

In 2025, iPhone 17 Pro Max remains a premium flagship — with a retail price starting from \$1,199.99 for the 256 GB model. Through AT&T's trade-in program and installment plan, buyers who meet certain requirements can reduce their monthly cost dramatically, often to just a few dollars per month. However, to take full advantage of the offer, you must trade in an eligible device, commit to AT&T's plan for 36 months, and accept that credits are distributed over time. and plan requirements — before making the decision.
