The start? When did Apple announce iPhone 17—and when did pre-orders start?

Apple officially unveiled the iPhone 17 lineup on 9 September 2025. That announcement covered several models: the standard iPhone 17, the new iPhone Air (replacing what used to be the "Plus" model), and the higher-end iPhone 17 Pro and iPhone 17 Pro Max.

The pre-order window opened on Friday, 12 September 2025 — at 5:00 a.m. Pacific Time (which corresponds to 1:00 p.m. UK time).

Retail availability (i.e. shipping to customers and availability in stores) started on Friday, 19 September 2025.

Availability of iPhone 17 in the UK—what's the situation?

According to Apple's UK press release, the iPhone 17 is sold in five colors — black, lavender, mist blue, sage, and white — and comes in storage versions of 256 GB and 512 GB.

The starting price for iPhone 17 in the UK was announced at £799.

At launch, Apple stated the device would be offered globally — including the UK — as part of its 63+ countries first-wave release.

That means UK customers who placed pre-orders early likely began receiving their devices the week of 19 September 2025. For those who didn't pre-order, some units may still appear in Apple Stores and select retailers — but stock could be limited, especially for popular colours and storage configurations.

What changed with iPhone 17—reasons for demand and potential supply issues

There are a number of upgrades in iPhone 17 that make it attractive to many buyers. Among them:

- A 6.3-inch Super Retina XDR display with ProMotion (high refresh rate) and improved brightness a notable upgrade from previous base models.
- A new 48 MP "Dual Fusion" main rear camera plus a 48 MP Fusion Ultra Wide for more detail and versatile shooting big improvements over prior generation entry-level cameras.
- The "Centre Stage" front camera offering a wider field of view for selfies, more stable video recording, and better group shots.

- More durable build with a new "Ceramic Shield 2" glass that's more scratch-resistant and reduces glare.
- Improved performance, battery life, and overall efficiency thanks to the A19 chip (or A19 Pro in Pro models), and modern wireless features making the new iPhone more future-proof.

Because of these upgrades and Apple's typical popularity in the UK, demand for iPhone 17 has been strong. As with many new flagship releases, early demand — combined with supply-chain and logistical constraints — can result in stock shortages shortly after launch. So while pre-orders guarantee a handset, walk-in buyers may face waiting lists or limited color/size availability in some shops.

Tips for UK buyers: how to secure iPhone 17 now

If you're trying to get your hands on iPhone 17 in the UK now, here are some practical tips:

- Check the official website or app regularly stock may refresh or new units may become available for "in store pickup."
- Be flexible about color and storage popular combinations (e.g. 256 GB in a trendy color) may run out first.
- Consider carrier deals or trade-in offers, which sometimes include subsidies or discounts with a new contract this can improve value, especially if you upgrade from an older device.
- If you don't rush, you may find online retailers or networks replenishing stock after the initial rush but expect waiting times or limited configurations.
