Emirates offers special discounts and benefits for full-time students aged 16 to 31. To get the discount, you must book directly on the Emirates website using a special promo code and have a valid student ID or acceptance letter.

Student discount details and perks

- Discounted fares: You can receive a discount of up to 10% on Economy Class and 5% on Premium Economy and Business Class fares.
- Promo code: The discount is applied during the booking process by entering the code STUDENT.

Emirates' baggage allowance is determined by your route, fare, and travel class, following either a "weight concept" or "piece concept".

Checked baggage

Weight concept (most routes)

This model applies to most international routes, where you can check in as many bags as you like, as long as the total weight does not exceed the limit for your class.

- First Class: 50 kg (110 lbs)
- Business Class: 40 kg (88 lbs)
- Premium Economy: 35 kg (77 lbs)
- Economy Class:
 - Flex Plus: 35 kg (77 lbs)
 - Flex: 30 kg (66 lbs)
 - Saver: 25 kg (44 lbs)

- Special: 20 kg (33 lbs)

Important restrictions: Each bag cannot weigh more than 32 kg (70 lbs) or have total dimensions exceeding 300 cm (118 inches).

Piece concept (to/from the Americas and Africa)

For travel to and from the Americas and Africa, the allowance is based on the number and weight of bags.

- First and Business Class: Two bags, each up to 32 kg (70 lbs).
- Premium Economy and Economy (Saver, Flex, Flex Plus): Two bags, each up to 23 kg (50 lbs).
- Economy (Special): One bag up to 23 kg (50 lbs).

Important restrictions: Each bag's total dimensions must not exceed 150 cm (59 inches). Bags between 150 cm and 300 cm will incur a fee, while those over 300 cm must be shipped as cargo.

Cabin (carry-on) baggage

- First and Business Class: Two pieces (briefcase plus handbag or garment bag), each up to 7 kg (15 lbs).
- Economy and Premium Economy: One piece (handbag or laptop bag) up to 7 kg (15 lbs).
- Maximum dimensions for all cabins: Handbag or laptop bag: 55 x 38 x 20 cm. Briefcase: 45 x 35 x 20 cm. Garment bag: 20 cm thick when folded.

Excess baggage

You can buy extra baggage allowance online at a lower rate than paying at the airport.

Special allowances

Infants' strollers, car seats, or carriers can be checked for free. Sports equipment, like golf clubs and skis, are part of the standard allowance but may incur excess fees. Small musical instruments can be carry-on, while larger ones must be checked or have a seat purchased.

JetBlue's baggage allowance includes a personal item and a carry-on bag for all customers, with checked bag fees varying based on your fare type and when you purchase the bag.

Carry-on baggage

All JetBlue passengers, including those with Blue Basic fares, are allowed one personal item and one carry-on bag free of charge.

- Personal item: Must fit under the seat in front of you. While there is no weight limit, the maximum dimensions are 17 x 13 x 8 inches (43.2 x 33 x 20.32 cm).
- Carry-on bag: Stored in the overhead bin. There is no weight limit for carry-on bags.

Checked baggage

The cost for checked bags depends on your fare and the timing of your purchase. For domestic flights, bags must adhere to the following limits:

- Weight: Up to 50 pounds (22.68 kg).

Flights from Los Angeles (LAX) to Las Vegas (LAS) are the quickest way to travel, taking about 1 hour and 15 minutes. As of May 28, 2025, Southwest Airlines has ended its policy of two free checked bags for most customers. Baggage fees and free allowances now depend on your fare type and loyalty status.

Carry-on baggage

Every passenger is allowed one carry-on bag and one personal item at no charge.

- Carry-on bag: Must fit in the overhead bin and not exceed 24" (L) x 16" (W) x 10" (H).
- Personal item: Must fit under the seat in front of you. Examples include a purse, briefcase, laptop bag, or small backpack.
- Exempt items: Items like outer garments, food for the flight, walking canes, and child restraint systems do not count toward your carry-on limit.

Checked baggage

The previous "Bags Fly Free" policy now only applies to specific fare classes and loyalty tiers. For all other passengers, checked bags incur a fee.

- New baggage fees (for most fares):

- First checked bag: \$35.
- Second checked bag: \$45.
- Size and weight limits: Each bag must not exceed 50 lbs and 62 inches (length + width + height).
- Free checked bag exceptions: Certain passengers still receive free checked bag allowances:
 - Two free bags: Passengers with a Business Select or Choice Extra fare, or those who are Rapid Rewards A-List Preferred members.
 - One free bag: Rapid Rewards A-List members and Southwest credit card holders.
 - Active-duty military: Service members can check more than two bags for free, provided each does not exceed 100 pounds or 80 inches.

Overweight and oversized bag fees

If your checked bag exceeds the standard weight or size limits, you will be charged additional fees.

- Overweight (51–100 lbs): \$75 per bag.
- Oversized (62–80 inches): \$75 per bag.
- Items over 100 lbs or 80 inches cannot be checked as baggage and may need to be sent as cargo.

How to pay for baggage

Applicable baggage fees can be paid at the airport using self-tagging kiosks or with a Southwest agent at the ticket counter. Only physical credit cards are accepted for payment at the airport; contactless payments are not.
