Since the general release on September 19, 2025, iPhone 17 models are already available in many markets. That means if you delayed your upgrade in 2025, you can now purchase the iPhone 17 (or its Air / Pro variants) through official channels and many retailers.

It's also worth noting that the release schedule for iPhone 17 might mark a transition point. According to recent reports, starting in 2026 Apple could begin to shift away from a pure fall-only launch model — meaning future iPhone releases might be split between spring and fall.
