Launch and Availability in Saudi Arabia

The iPhone 17 lineup — including the standard iPhone 17, plus versions like , , and — was officially introduced by in September 2025. Pre-orders in Saudi Arabia began on September 12, with general availability starting September 19. All models launched with base storage of 256 GB; Pro Max for the first time offered up to 2 TB storage.

Official Apple Saudi announcement confirms that iPhone 17 Pro and Pro Max are being sold in multiple storage configurations, with official local pricing starting from certain SAR (Saudi riyal) amounts.

Official iPhone 17 Prices in Saudi Arabia (as of November 2025)

According to recent aggregated price listings for KSA, the official retail prices for iPhone 17 models are approximately:

- iPhone 17 (base model, 256 GB) — SAR 3,799
- iPhone 17 (512 GB) — around SAR 4,799
- iPhone 17 Pro — starts at SAR 5,199
- iPhone 17 Pro Max — starts at SAR 5,699

These prices reflect official Apple-authorized retail pricing in Saudi Arabia, inclusive of standard regional taxes/VAT.

Where to Buy, Stores and Pre-Order Options

At launch and in early availability stages, several official retail chains and online stores in Saudi Arabia listed iPhone 17 at or near these official prices. For example, major retailers like , and local Apple-authorized resellers offered pre-orders and installment plans.

Pre-order deals sometimes allowed buyers to pay in installments — making high-end iPhone more accessible.

What the Price Means—What to Check Before Buying

When looking at the official price in Saudi Arabia, keep in mind several practical factors:

- **Model and storage matter.** The base 256 GB variant is significantly cheaper than the 512 GB, and the Pro/Pro Max models have a distinct premium. Choosing right model/storage is important.

- **Resale and import considerations.** If buying abroad and importing, factor in customs, taxes, and warranty — often price advantage erodes after these costs.

Why iPhone 17 Price Is Higher than Some Previous Models

The price bump in the iPhone 17 lineup compared to older iPhones reflects several upgrades and changes by Apple. The standard model now ships with 256 GB storage by default, rather than lower base storage. The Pro and Pro Max models use a more advanced chipset and offer high-end camera systems, enhanced displays, more storage options, and other premium features.

Moreover, Apple's launch strategy — offering multiple variants (standard, Air, Pro, Pro Max) — means pricing spans a wide range to cover both budget-conscious buyers (for a premium smartphone) and those prioritizing top-tier specs.
