Official Philippine Retail Prices for iPhone 17 Pro

- **Storage options** — From 256 GB up to 1 TB, which means plenty of space for apps, photos, videos, and heavy

usage without worrying about storage limitations.

These upgrades position the iPhone 17 Pro as a flagship-class smartphone in Apple's 2025 lineup, comparable with other high-end devices in features and performance — hence the corresponding price tag.

Should You Buy at These Prices in 2025?

It depends on your needs and how you plan to use the phone. The iPhone 17 Pro at ₱79,990 for 256 GB is a reasonable entry into Apple's "Pro" class — good for users who want performance, camera quality, and longevity.

If you plan to keep your phone for several years, or if you take a lot of photos/videos, or use heavy apps (like video editing, large games, content creation), paying extra for higher storage (512 GB or 1 TB) may well be worth it.
