Official iPhone 17 Pricing in Dubai (2025)

The official launch prices for the iPhone 17 series in UAE were announced in September 2025. The base iPhone 17 (standard model) starts at **AED 3,399** for the 256 GB version. A higher-capacity 512 GB variant is priced at **AED 4,249**.

For context, other models in the 2025 iPhone 17 lineup at Dubai stores are priced as follows: the iPhone 17 Air begins at around AED 4,299; iPhone 17 Pro at about AED 4,699; and iPhone 17 Pro Max from AED 5,099.

Thus, if you plan to buy the standard iPhone 17 — a great balance of features and value — expect to pay AED 3,399 (≈ 256 GB). If you want more storage, the 512 GB model for AED 4,249 is the next step up. If you prefer high-performance or premium models, expect the higher Pro / Pro Max prices.

Availability at Dubai Mall and What Happened at Launch

The new iPhone 17 lineup was made available in UAE stores on and after September 19, 2025.

On launch day at the Dubai Mall Apple Store, the atmosphere was intense: many eager buyers queued early in the morning. Most early customers gravitated toward the Pro Max model. Standard iPhone 17 units were also in demand, but Pro and Pro Max consistently drew the largest crowds.

Retailers in UAE have been offering trade-in deals and installment plans — for example, some stores allow buyers to trade their older devices for discounts or to pay over several months with 0% interest.

Resale Market and Price Fluctuations Near Dubai Mall

Given the strong demand for iPhone 17—especially Pro and Pro Max—a parallel resale market quickly emerged in Dubai, including near the Dubai Mall. Some reselling phones were being offered at a premium over official retail price, especially in early days.

For instance, certain Pro Max 1TB or 2TB variants were reportedly listed for amounts significantly higher than retail, as buyers who missed launch day were willing to pay extra.

That said, experts warn this spike may not last long. As supply stabilises, and more stock arrives in official stores, resale premiums tend to decrease.

Why Dubai Remains Attractive for iPhone 17 Buyers

There are a few reasons why people from all over the world — tourists, travellers, expatriates — still consider buying iPhone 17 at Dubai Mall worthwhile:

- Official Apple pricing with VAT included. Buying directly at the Apple Store or authorised retailers (e.g. Premium Resellers) ensures you pay the standard AED 3,399 / 4,249 for base models.
- **Wide stock and availability.** At launch, most variants were available including different colors and storage options.

- Check color and storage availability beforehand. Some popular colors or high-storage variants (512 GB, 1 TB) tend to run out early; ensure the store has the exact configuration you want before you commit.
- **Be cautious with reseller offers.** Price premiums in resale are common but warranty, authenticity, or support may be uncertain. If you care about full Apple warranty, buying from the official store or authorised retailer is safer.
