The new iPhone 17 Pro Max has already been officially unveiled — and for many fans the main question now is: when exactly will it be available in stores? In this article we walk you through the key dates, pre-order schedule, and what to know about the release of the iPhone 17 Pro Max in 2025.

7 When was iPhone 17 Pro Max announced and when did it release?

Apple officially presented the iPhone 17 Pro Max at its fall 2025 launch event on September 9, 2025. Alongside it, the iPhone 17, iPhone 17 Air, and iPhone 17 Pro also appeared.

Pre-orders for the new lineup began shortly after — on Friday, September 12, 2025 at 5 a.m. Pacific Time (which translates to local opening times in various regions).

The standard release date (i.e. first day of general sales and deliveries) for iPhone 17 Pro Max was Friday, September 19, 2025.

In some markets — depending on region and supply chain — availability might begin a little later. For example, while many countries got access starting September 19, additional countries and regions had official availability beginning September 26, 2025.

What to know about the official release schedule and pre-orders

Apple followed its traditional launch cadence in 2025: a major announcement in early September, pre-orders a few days later, then general availability within about a week.

This year the timing looked like this:

- Announcement: September 9, 2025
- **Pre-orders begin**: September 12, 2025
- On-sale date / deliveries start: September 19, 2025 (or September 26 in some regions)

If you pre-ordered on day one, you likely were among the first batch of buyers to receive the phone starting September 19. But as with any global launch, actual delivery times might vary — depending on local stock, shipping logistics, and retailer load.

Availability worldwide — will iPhone 17 Pro Max arrive in your country quickly?

Apple confirmed that iPhone 17 Pro Max pre-orders and sales would be available in more than 60 countries and regions as part of the first wave.

For some countries beyond the first wave, the device becomes available a bit later (from September 26, 2025).

If you live in a region included in the first release wave — like major markets in Asia, North America, Europe — you should have been able to secure pre-orders on September 12 and receive your unit soon after. For other regions, check with local Apple resellers for their confirmed stock dates.

Why Apple sticks to early September launches—and what this means for future iPhones

Traditionally, Apple uses early September for unveiling its flagship iPhones. This timing aligns with the back-to-school and holiday shopping seasons — when demand is high.

Experts expected iPhone 17 Pro Max to follow the same pattern in 2025 — and indeed, that prediction came true.

For users this means predictability: each fall we can reasonably expect a new iPhone flagship announcement, preorders a few days later, and shipping shortly thereafter. So if you plan to upgrade regularly, this rhythm helps with planning ahead — especially in terms of trade-ins, budgets, or selling older devices.

Should you expect delays or stock shortages?

With any major smartphone launch, initial demand often outstrips supply. Although pre-orders started promptly and Apple listed the release date publicly, some buyers may experience delayed deliveries depending on region, storage variant, or color choice. This is a common reality for global launches.

For example, while many early buyers received their devices around the launch date, some retailers and carriers — especially outside the first-wave markets — may still be catching up. If supply constraints hit your region, the official availability date might slide by several days or even weeks.





Conclusion — the bottom line on iPhone 17 Pro Max release

The iPhone 17 Pro Max was announced on September 9, 2025, pre-orders opened on September 12, and general sales started on September 19 (with some staggered regional roll-outs as late as September 26). If you ordered early and are in a first-wave country, you likely got your hands on the device already. If you're in a region outside the first batch — or selected a rare storage variant or color — you might still need to wait a little longer for availability.

In short: the official release happened. But when exactly *you* get your phone depends on location, demand, and supply chain. If you haven't checked yet — look into local authorized resellers or Apple's regional store for the most accurate status. The iPhone 17 Pro Max is now a real, shipping product — not a rumor.
