These prices apply to all official colour variants — black, white, mist blue, sage, and lavender.

As for other models in the 2025 series: the "Air", "Pro", and "Pro Max" are significantly more expensive, reflecting their enhanced features and hardware.

Why iPhone 17 Price Is What It Is—Factors Behind the Cost

Several factors contribute to the final retail price of iPhone 17 in India:

- **Upgrade in hardware and features:** iPhone 17 now offers a larger 6.3-inch Super Retina XDR display with ProMotion (up to 120 Hz), a more powerful A19 chip, a new 48 MP dual-fusion rear camera system, and enhanced durability including Ceramic Shield 2 glass. These improvements add to the manufacturing cost.
- **Storage change:** The base model starts at 256 GB instead of older 128 GB, which increases base production cost and justifies a higher entry price.
- Taxes, import duties, and localization costs: Devices sold in India must account for GST, import duties (where applicable), and other supply-chain costs. That typically pushes the price higher compared to U.S. or European markets.
- Market positioning: Apple tends to keep its premium devices at high-end price points. The 2025 lineup reflects that especially for Pro and Pro Max variants which are aimed at buyers needing flagship-level performance

and camera capabilities.

For the base iPhone 17 model at ₹82,900, buyers receive a device that's significantly upgraded compared to previous non-Pro iPhones. Some of the highlights:

- **Display:** 6.3-inch Super Retina XDR with ProMotion (up to 120 Hz refresh rate) and peak brightness around 3000 nits.
- **Camera**: Rear 48 MP dual-fusion system for sharper photos; improved low-light performance; upgraded front camera for better selfies and video calls.
- **Performance:** Powered by Apple's A19 chip, ensuring smooth performance, efficient battery use, and future-proofing against upcoming iOS updates.

Given the combination of display, performance, camera, and storage upgrades, many consider iPhone 17 to represent a "sweet spot" — offering flagship-level features but at a more reasonable price than Pro variants.
