Official iPhone 17 Pro US Pricing & Storage Options

As of its launch in September 2025, Apple lists the starting price for the iPhone 17 Pro at **\$1,099 (USD)**. This base price covers the model with **256 GB storage** — a change from previous years when base storage was lower.

For those needing more capacity, higher-storage versions are also available: the 512 GB model is priced at around **\$1,299 (USD)**, and the 1 TB configuration costs about **\$1,499 (USD)**.

These price points reflect a modest increase compared to the previous generation, but Apple's decision to double the base storage — from 128 GB to 256 GB — helps offset the hike for many buyers.

Why the Price Increased — And What's New

How iPhone 17 Pro Compares to Previous Generation (iPhone 16 Pro)

By comparison, the previous model — started at a lower storage base (128 GB) and had a price point around \$999.

That means the jump to \$1,099 with 256 GB storage represents both an increase in cost and a meaningful upgrade in storage capacity. For many users, doubling storage while only modestly increasing price can be a valuable trade-off. For others — especially those who rarely need more than 128 GB — the higher price might feel less justified.
