- If you shoot a lot of high-resolution video, do content creation, or want to keep large media libraries offline, 512
 GB or 1 TB could be worth the extra cost. The jump from 256 GB → 512 GB is CA\$ 300; from 512 GB → 1 TB adds another CA\$ 300. Considering the potential lifespan of the device, the higher storage may pay off long-term.

Other Pricing Considerations in Canada

- Prices listed are before tax: the final price will be higher after provincial sales tax (GST/HST/PST depending on province).

However, you might want to wait or reconsider if:

- You don't store many files locally in this case, 256 GB might be overkill, or perhaps a less expensive model in the iPhone 17 lineup (non-Pro) could meet your needs.
- Price after taxes and local fees pushes you beyond budget sometimes carrier financing or trade-in can help, but you should calculate total cost before committing.
