Retail Price in Japan

According to the official Japanese site of , the base model of iPhone 17 Pro — with 256 GB of storage — starts at **¥179,800 (tax included)**. This positioning makes the 256 GB storage the new standard, as Apple has dropped lower-capacity tiers for the 2025 lineup.

Although Apple lists only the starting price on its official store, third-party retailers in Japan show similar pricing: many list the iPhone 17 Pro 256 GB SIM-free around ¥178,626–¥179,800 depending on the retailer and its promotions.

Storage Options and What They Mean

For 2025, Apple simplified the storage lineup. The iPhone 17 Pro is offered in 256 GB, 512 GB and 1 TB variants. According to Japanese retail-price charts, the starting price of ¥179,800 applies to the 256 GB version; higher capacities are expected to cost more, though Apple Japan's official page does not always list all variants' prices.

This storage-first approach reflects a shift: 256 GB is now the “new baseline” for what counts as a serious flagship smartphone. For buyers who shoot lots of photos or video, or who prefer to store media locally rather than rely on cloud storage, the larger-capacity models make more sense — but come at a higher cost.

Why iPhone 17 Pro in Japan Is Considered Relatively “Affordable” Globally

Despite being a high-end flagship, iPhone 17 Pro in Japan is often ranked among the more affordable major markets. According to a global survey of 39 countries, Japan is one of the countries with the lowest price for iPhone 17, and while Pro-class models tend to be more expensive globally, Japan remains among the cheaper markets for them.

For many potential buyers outside Japan, this relative affordability may make Japan an attractive purchase destination — especially considering exchange rates and any upcoming travel plans.

What You Get for the Price — iPhone 17 Pro Features

Paying ~¥179,800 for iPhone 17 Pro secures you a device equipped with Apple's latest hardware advancements. Some of the key features include:

- An A19 Pro chip, delivering stronger performance and efficient power usage compared with previous generations.

- Super Retina XDR display with ProMotion technology and always-on display — great for smooth scrolling, vivid visuals, and battery-efficient use.
- An upgraded camera system: Pro-level “Fusion” cameras, supporting high-quality photo and video capture, with more powerful zoom and improved low-light performance.

For context: with the 2025 release of the 17 series, Apple dropped 128 GB as an entry-level storage option — a move that aligns with modern usage patterns. At the same time, price increases compared to the 2024 lineup are modest for Pro models.

Therefore, buyers upgrading from iPhone 16-series or older may appreciate both the enhanced specs and reasonable price bump for the quality they get, especially if they go for the 256 GB baseline rather than higher-cost models.

Availability and Release Timing in Japan

Officially, the release schedule for iPhone 17 Pro in Japan began with pre-orders from 12 September 2025, with sales starting on 19 September.

For buyers scrambling to secure one: early sources indicated that stock — especially of SIM-free 256 GB units in popular colors — could be limited just after launch, so pre-order or early purchase via official channels was advised.

What to Watch Out For: Practical Considerations

Although the price in Japan is competitive globally, there are a few practical considerations if you plan to buy in Japan and use it elsewhere (or if you're a non-resident — for example, a tourist):
