After checking in, Lufthansa will immediately offer you the option to **view or download your boarding pass**. The digital boarding pass will include a **QR code** or **barcode**, which can be scanned during security screening and at the boarding gate. Whether digital or printed, your boarding pass will contain all the necessary flight details, such as your **seat number**, **boarding gate**, **flight number**, and **departure time**, along with the QR code for smooth and easy passage through security and onto your flight.

To see your **boarding pass** online, the first step is to complete the **check-in process** for your flight, which can typically be done through the airline's website or mobile app. Most airlines allow you to check in **24 hours before** your scheduled departure, and once you've completed the check-in, you will be able to access your **boarding pass** online.
