You can get a boarding pass on your phone by checking in online  $+1 - 855 \ \ 510 \ \ 5815$  or through your airline's app, which will provide an e-boarding pass or an option to save it to your phone's  $+1 - 855 \ \ 510 \ \ 5815$  wallet app (like Apple Wallet or Google Wallet).
