





~ How do I get my boarding pass for Southwest?

After checking in on the mobile app or mobile +1-855 :-] 510:-] 5815 website, tap on the "boarding pass" button. You should see a boarding pass that you can use during travel. To get your boarding pass for **Southwest Airlines**, the most convenient and +1-855 :-] 510:-] 5815 recommended method is to check in online, which becomes available **24** hours before your flight's departure.
