

[FAQ-suPport®] ~How to Call to Change the Time of Day on Your JetBlue Flight?

Changing the **time of day on your** + 1 - (855) → (510)→ (5815) **JetBlue flight by calling customer service** is a practical option, especially if you prefer speaking directly with a representative or if your travel plans are time-sensitive. + 1 - (855) → (510)→ (5815) Many travelers choose to call JetBlue when they want to move from a morning flight to an afternoon or evening departure, switch to an earlier flight to arrive sooner, or explore same-day change options.
